Dear Parents / Carers,

As another busy half-term comes to a close, I am writing to provide you with a few important updates and reminders.

Half-term holidays

The children's last day in school is Thursday 21st May. Friday 22nd May is an INSET day. Children will return to school on Monday 1st June.

Clubs

There will be no clubs the last week of Term (Monday 18th May to Thursday 21st May) or the first week back (Monday 1st June to Friday 5th June).

Pupil attendance and punctuality

If your child is absent, please ring the school to report it, as we do not receive notifications of text messages. Our preferred methods of communication are a phone call or informing the office staff in person. If you are planning a holiday during term time, please request a holiday form in advance. Mrs Saunders will contact you if you have not provided a reason for absence. We need to record the reason for absence, this is an important part of the school's approach to safeguarding. Mrs Saunders and I regularly conduct house visits if there is no communication. Whilst we appreciate that sometimes delays are unavoidable, please ensure, wherever possible, that your child arrives at school on time.

Parking

A gentle reminder regarding parking: we strongly encourage families to walk to school whenever possible to ease congestion. Please do not park in residents' bays or on yellow zig-zag lines. It is imperative that parents refrain from dropping off children at the crossing or parking on the white crossing lines, as this endangers our pupils. Parking on the pavements of Creidiol Road forces children and adults to walk on the road and creates a hazardous situation. I am deeply concerned that an accident may occur and therefore urge your cooperation in this matter.

Parent behaviour

It is important that we set a good example for our pupils by modelling appropriate language and resolving disagreements amicably. Please do not argue, shout or fight inside or outside of the school grounds. Please also consider the example we set on social media, as this guides children in how to behave in different situations. I also ask that you refrain from smoking and vaping directly outside the school gate and ensure that your interactions with staff remain courteous and respectful.
