OUR PHASE STRUCTURE AND CLASSES

At Sea View Community Primary School, our teachers have always worked collaboratively in phases to plan learning, share expertise and ensure a consistent approach across year groups. While this way of working is not new, we are introducing names for each phase to help children identify with their stage of learning and celebrate their journey through the school.

Children will progress through the following phases during their time at Sea View:

- **Forest Phase** - Nursery and Reception
- **Sea Phase**- Years 1 and 2
- **Mountain Phase**- Years 3 and 4
- **Sky Phase** -Years 5 and 6

We hope these phase names will strengthen children's sense of belonging and provide a clear picture of their progression through the school, from their first days in Nursery right through to Year 6.

As children are active throughout the school day, taking part in outdoor play, creative activities and a wide range of learning experiences, we kindly ask that you do not send your child to school in expensive clothing. It is inevitable that clothing may become dirty during normal school activities.

Children should wear sensible and suitable footwear at all times. School shoes or trainers are appropriate. Crocs, sliders and similar footwear are not permitted as they do not provide adequate support or safety for children during learning and play.

To help keep costs down, plain white or blue T-shirts and polo shirts can be purchased economically from most supermarkets and clothing retailers, often in multipacks. These are perfectly acceptable as part of our school uniform. The school is also hoping to be able to have some stock available to distribute to families. The **School Essentials Grant is open now** and supports families with children in reception to year 11 on lower incomes and who [get certain benefits](#).

The school office sells school jumpers only, which are available to purchase from Reception at a cost of £10 (cash only). The office will be open for jumper sales on:

Please ensure that all school jumpers, cardigans and coats are clearly labelled with your child's name. This helps us return lost items to their owners quickly and reduces the amount of clothing left in lost property.
