Comic Relief

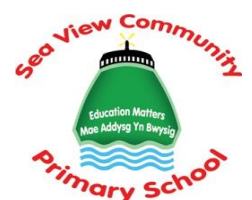
The school raised £97.91 for Red Nose Day. Thank you to everyone who participated in events and made donations.

Parking

We are currently working with the councillors, residents of Creidiol Road and a group of parents to improve parking and safe routes to school. There has been an increased presence outside the school of the traffic wardens, PCSOs and school staff. A small minority of parents continue to park on pavements and stop outside the school. Please **DO NOT** park on the zigzag lines directly outside the school or stop outside to drop off or pick up, even if just for a few minutes – you are not allowed! As a school, we are worried that one of our children will be hit by a car. Parking on the zigzag lines impedes the clear view of pedestrians walking on the narrow pavement and those using the zebra crossing. Also, parking on pavements forces parents and children to walk on the road to get around the cars. The safety of the children is the most important thing, so please be mindful, park where permitted, and then walk to the school. Thank you for your support.

ESTYN Inspection Report

ESTYN inspected the school from 27th January to 29th January. Four inspectors visited the school who observed lessons, talked to the children, looked at books and met with parents, staff and governors. When ESTYN visits schools, they produce a report highlighting the school's strengths and provide recommendations for the school to work on. The inspectors were very complimentary about our pupils' work, behaviour and engagement in their learning. Our report highlights strengths in well-being provision for pupils and families, inclusion and celebration of diversity, support for ALN, leadership, and community engagement while identifying the need to continue to develop our provision for the youngest pupils and focus on improving Welsh language learning. ADDITIONAL LEARNING NEEDS AT SEA VIEW

Whilst I am acting head, I will also continue with the ALNCo role. As always, if you are worried that your child may be having difficulty with their learning, please speak to the class teacher in the first instance. They know your child best and will be able to discuss their learning with you in detail.

If it is felt that your child may need more support, then the class teacher will speak to me as the Additional Learning Needs co-ordinator (ALNCO). Whilst I am headteacher, other staff members from the school's ALN team may carry out some of the ALN work, such as meeting with parents to complete questionnaires, attending review meetings and completing referrals. This work will be undertaken under my direction and supervision.

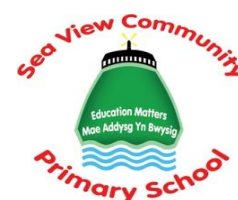
