Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you are all well and a warm welcome back to school! It has been a joy to see the children again today and we are looking forward to another happy and successful year at Sea View.

MEET THE TEACHER

We have Meet the Teacher sessions next Wednesday 17th September at 3.45pm and 4.15pm. This is an opportunity for you to meet your child's teacher, see their new classroom and find out what they will be doing in school this year as well as ask any questions you have about school. We hope to see as many of you there as possible. You only need to attend one of the sessions. If you have more than one child in the school, you can attend two sessions.

START OF THE DAY

Y1 – Y6 Teachers will be available on the yard from 8.50am – 9.00am if you need to speak to them, but we do aim to take the children in promptly at 9.00am. You can always ring the school to ask the teacher to give you a call back after school if you need to share important information with them. Please send the children to lines promptly when the bell goes and stay behind the halfway line so we can see the children clearly. Doors to Forest Phase will be opened from 9.00am but Mrs Davies will be outside in the Forest Phase outdoor area from 8.50am. Learning starts as soon as children arrive in their classrooms, so please try to ensure that your child arrives on time each day so they do not miss key parts of the morning session.

COLLECTING CHILDREN AT THE END OF THE DAY

We ask that parents don't cross into the second half of the yard where the children are dismissed but wait until the teacher sees you and dismisses the child to you – we don't want any children to get lost or go missing so please be patient, your child's safety is our priority. Please do not allow younger children to play on the wooden climbing frames and equipment at the end of the day. Also, please be reminded that we do not allow dogs onto the school premises. Thank you for your support.

COURTESY TO SCHOOL STAFF

We value, and are proud of our positive relationships with our families and will do all we can to support you and your child. We politely ask that you are respectful and calm when speaking to members of staff. Please be assured we all have your child's best interests at heart and want the very best for all of our children and families. There were a few isolated incidences last year where members of staff were shouted at or felt threatened, which is not acceptable. We also request that you are mindful of posts on social media. If you have any worries or concerns, please make an appointment with the school office to speak to me, Miss Wilcox or Mrs Saunders.

SCHOOL PHOTOGRAPHS

The photographer will be in school on Monday September 22nd to take school photos. Unfortunately, we are unable to invite siblings who are not in the school for photographs this year.



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PARENT/CARERS CONSULTATIONS

Parents consultations will take place during the week of **24th – 27th October**. Teachers will send out appointments nearer the time. Please make every effort to attend to find out how your child/children have settled, to see their work so far and to find out how you can support them to make progress in their learning.

ATTENDANCE

We continue to work on improving attendance and punctuality. Welsh Government target for attendance is 95%. Please remember to call the school office in the morning if your child is absent due to illness. We are keen to work with parents to improve attendance and are happy to meet with you to discuss any problems or issues impacting on attendance and punctuality.

ADDITIONAL LEARNING NEEDS

If you are worried about your child's progress in school, please speak to the classteacher in the first instance. If you would like to make an appointment with one of our ALN team, please, make an appointment with the school office and they will book you in with the appropriate person.

BREAKFAST CLUB

Breakfast club is available for all pupils from morning Nursery to Year 6. Breakfast club begins at 8.30am and doors close at 8.45am. If you wish your child to attend breakfast club please bring them to the door in the yard where staff will meet them.
